

## Home testing – Covid-19

Students have received three Covid tests at school. They now need to do their home tests on Sunday and Wednesday evenings and continue across the Easter holiday. The results for each test must be submitted to the school and the NHS. We recommend setting a reminder on your phone to do this. We encourage everybody in your house to get a test at their nearest home testing collection point or by ordering online here: <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>

- Following the instruction booklet, carefully do the home test then wait for 30 minutes.
- After 30 minutes, check your LFD test for the result. Refer to the instruction booklet for guidance on how to interpret results.

### What to do once you have reported the result:

#### If your home test result is negative...

After reporting a negative home test to the school and NHS, you don't need to do anything else until your next home test, and can continue to come to school.

#### If your home test result is positive...

After reporting a positive home test to the school and NHS, you must book a PCR test at your local centre and isolate until your appointment. If your PCR result is negative, you can return to school, but if your result is positive, you must continue to isolate for a further 10 days.

#### If your home test result is void...

You must still report a void result to the school and NHS, but then you must do the test again and report the result to both places for the second test. If your second test comes back void, you need to book a PCR test.
