

Teacher Subject Specialism Training (TSST) in Mathematics, Physics and MFL – French and Spanish

**Free training based at The Compton School
during the 2018-19 academic year**

The Compton-Barnet Teaching School Alliance is offering free training for qualified teachers to acquire additional skills to teach maths, physics or MFL (French and Spanish). This training is funded by the NCTL and supported by both the Joint Mathematical Council and the Institute of Physics.

The training is focusing on qualified teachers who are teaching outside of their specialism. This could be biology teachers teaching physics or maths teachers who do not originally train to teach maths.

Schools can access £780 per teacher who attends the programme.

Nationally only 18% of all science teachers have a physics degree and only 45% of all maths teachers have a maths degree (source: questionsforgovernors.uk/DfE data 2013).
